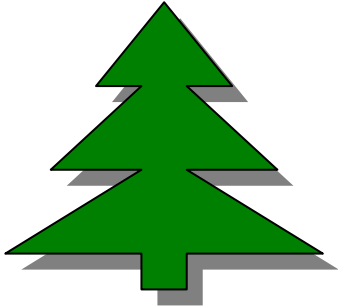
A Message from the Board
