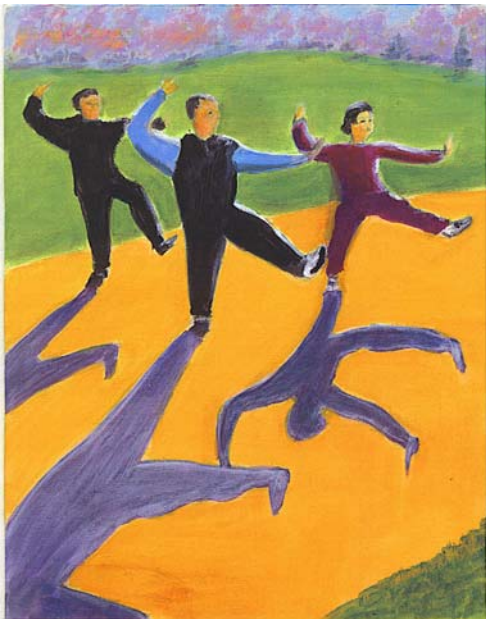


Deer Lake Gallery pre-
